

Update: COVID-19 Vaccination Policy

Eastern International College

Effective in the Summer 2023 semester, Eastern International College no longer requires COVID-19 vaccinations as a requirement for enrollment but strongly encourages vaccinations and boosters for those who are eligible. Federal regulations may still require students who work in specific settings, like healthcare, to be vaccinated and receive the booster.

Students whose degree requirements include completion of clinical rotations and externship may be required by the clinical agencies to be vaccinated. If unvaccinated, a student may not be accepted in the clinical site, which may result in non-completion of his/her degree program. The student may be asked to drop out or withdraw from the course. EIC does not provide on campus clinical/externship for nursing, DMS, and CVT students.
