With the theme "Nurses together: a force for global health", and in partnership with the Canadian Nurses Association, the ICN 2023 Congress provided a global hub of nursing and other health leaders, bringing together national nursing associations, global health leaders, expert speakers, clinicians, students, and academics. AUGUST 25, 2023

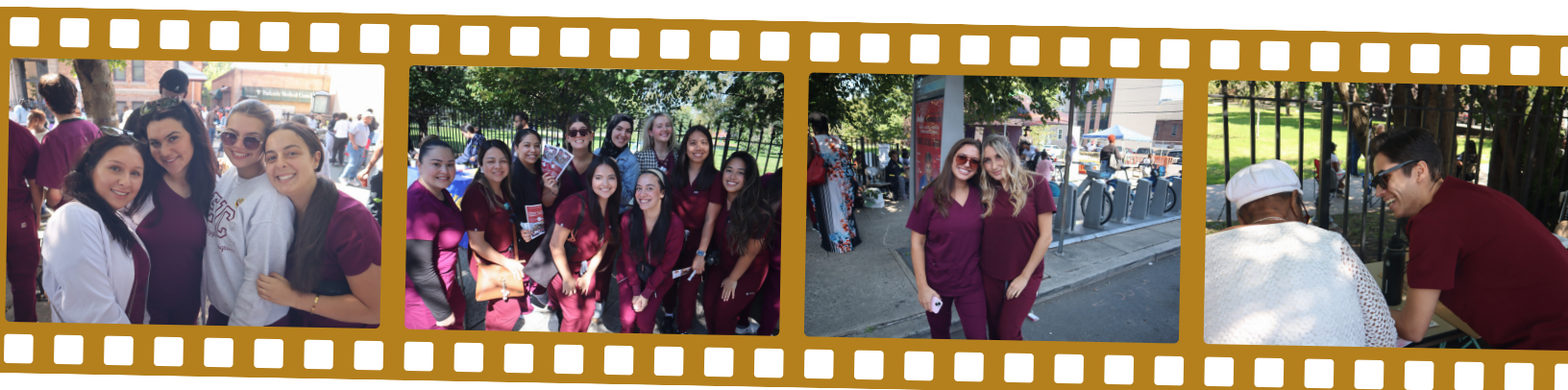

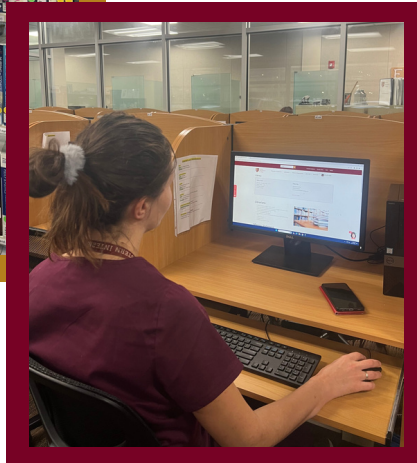

"I find the library at Eastern International College to be very helpful. I visit it almost every time I'm on campus. It is very welcoming. I also like big round tables, where many students can sit at the same time, I do group studies there with my fellow students, And it also gives us an opportunity to bond. Like for example we prepared together with five other girls for our final project for Medical Emergencies in the Dental Office, which was to create 2 possible emergency situations and how we would respond to them in a dental office setting. I have small kids at home,

and can't concentrate on my studies, so I use the library to study. It's always very quiet, which is perfect for me. I usually come there before the class if I have time, to do a last minute quick review of the material before the test. Also, I go there whenever we have a long break between classes. It's much more enjoyable for me to spend time in the library than in the student lounge, which can get quite chaotic. I use the printer there a lot, I am able to print in minutes, which is also very helpful. I can also photocopy pages from a book that I need if I don't have it at home. The library has all the necessary books that you can borrow, so whenever I'm planning on studying there I don't carry the books with me. So the library has been a really valuable resource for me. And I'm going to continue using it throughout my studies."

GRANTS

- Money awarded for educational expenses based on financial need. (Does not require repayment)
- Main Types
 - Federal Pell Grant
 - State Tuition Aid Grant

SCHOLARSHIPS

- Awarded based on specific requirements or criteria. (Does not require repayment)
- Main Types
 - Institutional Scholarships (On Campus)
 - National Scholarships

LOANS

- Awarded based on students' need and other criteria. (Requires repayment)
- Subsidized: Government pays down interest while in school
- Unsubsidized: Accrues interest while in school
- CollegeAve: Private loan
- NJCLASS: Private loan
