To be eligible for Latin Honors, a graduate must satisfy the following criteria:

## I. Summa Cum laude

- Must have completed at least 70% of the total coursework of the degree program in EIC. Only credits earned in EIC are included in the computation of the student's cumulative GPA. Online completion students must have completed at least 60% of the total coursework of the degree program in EIC.
- Cumulative GPA of 3.90 4.00
- Must have completed all externship, clinical and other department requirements.
- No failed grade
- No incomplete grade

# II. Magna Cum laude

- Must have completed at least 70% of the total coursework of the degree program in EIC. Only credits earned in EIC are included in the computation of the student's cumulative GPA. Online completion students must have completed at least 60% of the total coursework of the degree program in EIC.
- Cumulative GPA of 3.80 3.89
- Must have completed all externship, clinical and other department requirements.

## III. Cum laude
